Professional code of conduct:

As a Beauty therapist you must ensure that you follow a strict dress code as follows:

- > Clean ironed uniform
- Closed toe flat shoes
- Hair tied up
- > Day make up
- > Short unvarnished nails

Desired personal qualities of a therapist

- > Polite
- > Makes eye contact
- > Smiles
- Good Communicator
- Listens
- > Punctual

It is important for a therapist to maintain good personal hygiene as follows:

- > Ensure you wash daily, and yours hands before and after each clients
- > Ensure you wear body spray
- > Ensure your breath is fresh (particularly after food or smoking)
- > Ensure hair is washed and tied up.

It is important to be aware of current legislation regarding your work place. As a beauty therapist we have to ensure that our workplace provide, and that we use Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) an example of this would be:

- Disposable Gloves to ensure we do not have cross contamination between therapist and client
- Uniform so we do not ruin our personal clothing and to ensure hygiene
- > Disposable mask to protect therapist if dealing with any harmful fumes and also to stop the spread of infection from therapist to client e.g. cold.

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
