COURSE INFORMATION

AIMS

This course will help you to develop the language skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing. You will also improve your grammar and vocabulary. The course will prepare you to study on different English language courses.

- Grammar you will get to know the important rules.
- Vocabulary you will learn new words and use them in speaking and writing.
- Speaking and listening you will be able to understand clear speech and communicate more fluently and in more detail.
- Reading you will read stories, short articles, dialogues, for example to help your understanding and improve vocabulary.
- Writing you will write stories, descriptions, messages and dialogues to improve your writing.

QUALIFICATIONS

During this 18 week course you will attend college for 17 hours a week (16 for beginners classes). You will work towards achieving **Scottish Qualifications Authority** [SQA] national certificates in ESOL and Core Skills and Edinburgh College [EC] units.

COURSE CONTENT

TUTORIALS

Your main teacher will also be your tutor. You will speak to your tutor individually at the beginning of your course to agree a learning plan for you. You will meet your tutor at regular times in the course to discuss your plan and your progress.

ASSESSMENT AND PROGRESSION

Your teacher will check your progress regularly using course tests and homework. You will aim to complete all of the units listed in the box above.

You must achieve the objectives on your learning plan, complete your homework and come to 80% of your classes to get a college certificate.
