
Edinburgh College End of the Year Exhibition

Our graduate diploma shows in 2019 will be held at The Fruitmarket Gallery, City Art Centre, Edinburgh Sculpture Workshop and in our Art and Design Studios at Granton Campus.

Each year we produce a Graduate Book for our HND End of Year Exhibition which promotes our students into the world of work.

96% of our students progress into further study or employment.




