TICKETS

The graduation ceremonies are ticketed events and only those with a valid ticket will be permitted into the McEwan Hall.

All graduate tickets are free and guest tickets must be purchased at £6 each. A maximum of 6 guests tickets are allowed per graduate.

Tickets for children under 5 years old are free but must have a ticket.

All tickets once purchased are non-refundable.

ON THE DAY

Registration

Graduating students should arrive at the McEwan Hall no later than 1 hour before the start of their ceremony.

Registration for all graduates will take place in Foyer 4 of the McEwan Hall, entry via the pavilion entrance.

> All guests should enter the Hall through the main entrance on Bristo Squre.

No students may take part in the ceremony unless they have registered and received a seating card and collected their gown.

Graduating students must sit in the seat number given and cannot change or swap.

Guest tickets will also be collected on the day from registration.

Registration must be completed no later than **30 minutes** prior to the start of the ceremony.

Anyone arriving less than 30 minutes before the start of the ceremony may not be permitted to take part.



Gown Collection


Gown order must be collected following registration from the Robing Room in the McEwan Hall.
