As of 1 October 2012, Edinburgh's Telford College, Jewel & Esk College and Stevenson College merged to create a single college called Edinburgh College.

We refer to your request for information dated 18 January 2018. The College has considered your request as a request for information under section 1 of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 ("FOISA"):

002/18 (1): A list of all named retail outlets on the college grounds that sell tobacco and their location (grounds deemed to be owned, leased or used by the college or otherwise part of the college campus).

There are no outlets on college property which sell any form of tobacco.

002/18 (2): All details, including amounts, of any funding received from tobacco companies (including fully-owned subsidiaries of tobacco companies or any third parties acting on their behalf) to support research, staffing or any other activity carried out by the institution.

None.

002/18 (3): All details of college funds invested in tobacco companies, including amounts and including funds invested through pension funds and any other investment trusts.

None.
