As of 1 October 2012, Edinburgh's Telford College, Jewel & Esk College and Stevenson College merged to create a single college called Edinburgh College.

We refer to your request for information dated 10 July 2017. The College has considered your request as a request for information under section 1 of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 ("FOISA"):

049/16/17 (1) The current FTE equivalent number of support staff from the three pre merger legacy colleges that are covered by in-perpetuity payment protection under TUPE.

Please note, in-perpetuity pay protection remains in place until salaries match the banding in which a role has been evaluated.

049/16/17 (2) The current FTE equivalent number of support staff that are post merger members of staff.
